Effective rehearsals start with planning! Whether it's the chorus setting or a quartet rehearsal, planning is the first step to success!

Plan Ahead	*What do you want to accomplish? *Create a timed schedule to visualize the time spent on each component	* Identify what your goal is for each song/part of the rehearsal *create rehearsal timeline/outline in advance. Who's job is that?
Be Prepared	*What songs are on the line up? Are you prepared? *Do you know the traps? *Are you in touch with musical leadership/section leaders to identify problem areas?	*be on time *did you do your homework? *warm up- together or come warm? *leave your day outside of rehearsal *Simple things such as: do you have the music, pencil, pitch pipe, any other materials needed?
Stay on Task	*Time management is a must! Identify a time keeper? Set alarms on your phone? * How do you handle questions/comments from the risers	*parking lot-sticky note
Flexibility	* Teachable moments *Either behind/ahead of where you wanted to be	*understanding different learning styles *patience when working sections *to coach or not to coach
